






ADNAM'S

Established in 1872, Adnams is one of Britain's best-loved regional brewers. The earliest recorded brewing on the Adnams site in Suffolk was in 1345 and today Adnams is committed to brewing the finest cask, bottled and canned ales, as well as a range of premium spirits in its Copper House still. Adnams range of regular beers have attracted numerous awards at international level, including Gold for Adnams Dry Hopped Lager at the International Beer Challenge 2014.




Mosaic Pale Ale (4.1%)

Made with Mosaic hops, this pale blonde has real personality with bold mango, peach, lemon and pine flavours and a dry hoppy finish. Brewed with Pale Ale malt, some Lager malt and a touch of light Cara. This single hop beer uses Mosaic hops at each of the four stages of the brew process. This imparts bold hop characteristics, including peach, mango, lemon and pine flavours and aromas. With big fruity flavours and a Mosaic of aromas.

Crystal Rye IPA (5.0%)

Adnams Crystal Rye IPA uses a variety of North America hops – Columbus, Centennial, Cascade, Amarillo and Citra – to deliver delicious, big, bold, citrus and pine flavours and aromas to the beer. To balance the hops, the brewers add Rye, plus some Pale Ale and Cara Malt, to imbue sweetness, body and balance as well as some lovely subtle toffee flavours.



Innovation IPA (6.7%)

This 6.7% abv beer is the Adnams American style IPA. It's brewed with a blend of Wheat and Pale Ale malts to give a spicy, biscuity undertone to the beer, but it is in the hops where the beer really shines. A blend of hops from England, Slovenia and America (namely Boadicea, Columbus and Stryian Goldings) combine to give a wonderful grapefruit and tropical fruit aroma and bitterness that is balanced by the sweetness of the barley.

Dry Hopped Lager (4.2%)

Brewed with Pilsner malt, this authentic lager is then dry hopped with Australian Galaxy hops to add big, fruity hop flavours. Dry hopping allows the brewer to pack more of a flavour punch and adds brilliant hop aromas. It's then cold conditioned to produce a full, well rounded flavour. This golden lager is light, crisp and refreshing with subtle malty flavours and a super hoppy aroma of tropical fruits, citrus and passionfruit.
