



Chilgrove

Nestled at the foot of the English South Downs, surrounded by woodland and steeped in thousands of years of history and tradition lies the sleepy Sussex hamlet of Chilgrove. This beautiful corner of rural England is home to Chilgrove Dry Gin, the country's first gin to be made from grape spirit rather than the more usual cereal derived base.

Distilled with the natural mineral water that filters through the very chalk downs which surround Chilgrove, this gloriously English, modern-styled London Dry Gin marries 11 botanicals, including juniper, coriander seed, lime, angelica root and native English water mint, with its signature neutral grape spirit.

The result of this unusual relationship gives Chilgrove its sophisticated yet accessible character, summed up by Master Distiller Charles Maxwell as 'a big, powerful, complex gin', which lends itself during any season of the year to connoisseurs and casual G&T fans alike.

Tasting note: Distilled from local mineral water and neutral grape spirit, this is elegant and crisp with just a hint of fruit on the nose, a smooth, slightly earthy flavour and long finish.



Chilgrove Dry Gin

Alcohol: 44% ABV

Format: 70cl bottle

Tasting Note: A ripe, fruity and floral nose. The luscious elements of the grape come through, along with a little sweetness and warm spice. On the palate this is a very clean and smooth spirit; the different character that the base provides is evident from the outset. Notes of juniper, angelica and coriander come through, with bright citrus and then some mint and menthol notes on the finish. There's a long and lingering finish of mint and pine.
