## Crate Brewery

Beside a canal in east London's buzzing Hackney Wick district lies Crate, a craft brewery, bar and pizzeria that was built by locals and launched in July 2012 when the world's attention was fixed on the London Olympic Games taking place just a few hundred metres away.

From the start, Crate has epitomised the carefully brewed, full flavoured, hugely drinkable beers that characterise the craft beer revolution of recent years. Its ever expanding range is available in bottle, keg and cask with a canned option in the pipeline.

2013 saw the brewery expand into a nearby industrial warehouse, enabling the company to strike a perfect balance between increasing the number of customers it can supply and freeing up the original smaller facility for the creation of experimental brews that keep Crate pushing the boundaries of what is possible with beer and flavour.

For those curious to understand more about the beer making process and Crate's own ethos, the company offers 'behind the scenes' tasting tours of its brewery, including the chance to sample the individual ingredients that go into its winning recipes.
