One of the most exciting and dynamic of Britain's bright new generation of breweries, Fourpure was founded in 2013 by brothers Daniel and Thomas Lowe in Bermondsey, east London.

The name Fourpure marks the team's commitment to respecting the four key ingredients that make up beer: grain, yeast, hops and water. Its portfolio is inspired by some of the great beer styles and regions around the world.

This was the first British craft brewery to can its core range, which currently consists of six styles, supplemented by seasonal specials. In addition to the lighter environmental footprint of canned beer, this format offers the best protection from oxygen and light, ensuring that the product reaches its end consumer in the best possible condition.

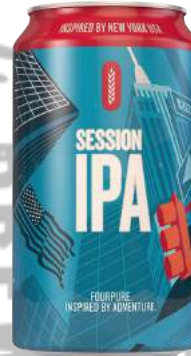

Pils
Format: 330ml cans, 20- & 30-litre kegs
Alcohol: 4.7% ABV
About: A take on the traditional Pilsner and inspired by cycling trips in Germany and the Czech Republic, this is generously hopped and made using Bavarian yeast.



American Pale Ale
Format: 330ml cans, 20- & 30-litre kegs
Alcohol: 5.0% ABV
About: A tribute to the classic American Pale Ale, this blends Cascade hops with balanced malts for a true West Coast-style session beer.



Session IPA
Format: 330ml cans, 20- & 30-litre kegs
Alcohol: 4.2% ABV
About: East Coast US attitude meets an aromatic blend of hops to create this clean session IPA style with a refreshingly dry finish.



Shape Shifter West Coast IPA
Format: 330ml cans, 20- & 30-litre kegs
Alcohol: 6.5% ABV
About: The world famous craft beer scene of Portland, Oregon, triggered this classic West Coast IPA mix of Cascade, Centennial and Chinook hops.



Flatiron American Red Ale
Format: 330ml cans, 20- & 30-litre kegs
Alcohol: 5.1% ABV
About: The result of a love affair with American Red Ale which started with a trip to Colorado, this carries plenty of aroma, backed by a distinctive malty note.



Oatmeal Stout
Format: 330ml cans, 20- & 30-litre kegs
Alcohol: 5.1% ABV
About: This smooth stout made with oats, British Goldings hops and dark chocolate malt represents a celebration of London's rich dark beer brewing history.
