



Hush Heath Estate

This beautiful private estate in the south-east of England has been home to the Balfour-Lynn family since the 1980s. Its winemaking era began in 2002, when Richard Balfour-Lynn planted his first vineyards on these clay-rich soils, with an ambition to make fine sparkling rosé.

That Balfour Brut Rosé has helped put this producer firmly on the English wine map, winning a Decanter Gold Medal in 2013 and being regularly served on the Orient Express and British Airways First Class flights, as well as being chosen as the only English wine to be served at the London 2012 Olympics.

Hush Heath has since introduced a second tier of traditional method sparkling wines under the '1503' label, a reference to the date when the estate's striking Tudor manor house was built. Made from the property's younger vineyards and with a slightly higher dosage, these offer a very approachable yet still refined English fizz experience. Similarly youthful and fresh in style is the estate's Leslie's Reserve NV, named after Richard's wife.

2018 saw Hush Heath take its aspirations to another level with the opening of a new, larger winery and enhanced, expanded visitor centre.



Balfour Brut Rosé 2014

Alcohol: 12% ABV
Format: 75cl bottle
Blend: 48% Chardonnay, 39% Pinot Noir, 13% Pinot Meunier
Tasting note: Delicate copper pink with a fine bead. Nose shows rosehip, greengage, apple and ginger. The palate is very refreshing with classic English mouthwatering acidity, notes of white currant, quince and lime lead to a long finish.



Balfour Leslie's Reserve NV

Alcohol: 12.0% ABV
Format: 75cl bottle
Blend: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Pinot Meunier
Tasting note: Bright gold with attractive pink highlights and a fine sustained mousse. The nose is fresh and clean with hints of brioche and red apple. A beautifully balanced sparkling wine with crisp acidity and a touch of sweetness.



Balfour 1503

Classic Cuvée NV
Alcohol: 11.5% ABV
Format: 75cl bottle
Blend: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Pinot Meunier
Tasting note: Pale gold with pink highlights and a fine, sustained bead. The nose is clean and fresh with lemony acidity, crisp apple and dried herbs, all of which continue onto the palate before a fresh and sustained finish.



Balfour 1503 Rosé NV

Alcohol: 11.5% ABV
Format: 75cl bottle
Blend: Pinot Noir, Chardonnay & Pinot Meunier
Tasting note: Delicate rose petal pink colour with a nose of bright citrus, wild strawberry and dried herbs. The palate is full of refined red berry fruit, pink grapefruit and lively acidity balanced with a touch of sweetness on the finish.
